... "yes I agree it has the diff-lock, disc-brakes and all those up-to-the-minute features. But it hasn't got the IH "Agriomatic" transmission!

Just take a good look at the combination of practical features the IH "Agriomatic" offers. For instance you can start or stop the tractor in the low range without declutching or engaging a gear, simply by pulling or pushing the "Agriomatic" lever.

This means if you are pulling a heavy load up a steep hill there's no need to declutch, change gears etc., just slip the "Agriomatic" lever in the low range and sail surely to the top.

As a safety measure, this same procedure applies when descending steep gradients.

Another advantageous feature is when working with P. T. O. driven machines, you run into a heavy patch of weedy growth, your tractor speed can be slowed down or stopped without effecting the speed of the P. T. O. by moving the "Agriomatic" lever. After the machine has "cleared itself", the "Agriomatic" lever is returned to low range position and again tractor moves forward.

With the aid of the "Agriomatic" extension lever "Quick-start stop-jobs" can be carried out such as loading hay, green feed or grain from the shock. This job is really a one-man operation, no time wasted mounting the tractor, no declutching and no gear changing. A pull or a push on the extension lever will stop or set the tractor in motion.

You see what I mean when I say it hasn't got the "Agriomatic" transmission?
